Electric Motorcycles

The Birmingham Police Department has observed a significant increase in the number of electronic motorcycles being operated within the City. Most of these devices are not only illegal to operate within the City, they also pose a significant safety risk to the riders, other motorists and pedestrians.

License Requirements

Electric Motorcycles (no pedals) are considered motorcycles under state law and as such, are prohibited on sidewalks and must be licensed through the Secretary of State. In order to obtain a license for the motorcycle it must meet all safety requirements to be street legal.

An operator of a street legal motorcycle must have a driver's license with a cycle endorsement.

Criminal Charges

The Police Department has observed the majority of users of these devices are underage minors. While there are certainly legal ramifications for those operating these devices illegally there are also ramifications for those purchasing them and allowing their unlicensed children to operate them.

Under Michigan Law Section 257.904, it is a Misdemeanor to allow an unlicensed person operate a motor vehicle.

The Birmingham Police Department asks for your cooperation in helping us to ensure everyone's safety by not permitting the use of these devices within the City.

Birmingham officers will be providing strict enforcement!

VII. New Business

1. OHM Update

The team from OHM and staff presented the item and answered questions.

Board members discussed the following regarding the item:

- The feedback boards were a useful method for synthesizing public feedback.
- The light, medium, and heavy intervention terminology should be replaced with more neutral terminology so that people do not select options based on perceived cost.
- Outdoor ice skating could be a valuable addition.
- The sports fields should be oriented so that the sun is less likely to be in players' eyes during regular game times.
- The public will have another opportunity to provide feedback, and OHM will return to a future Board meeting with another iteration based on feedback received.
- Exercise opportunities for adults could be located at St. James Park given its proximity to Next's future location. Shuffleboard might be a welcome recreational opportunity for this location.
- The OHM Team would be soliciting feedback from the defined user groups of the City's parks.
- It might be possible to reach the contact for the Girls' softball league at the Varsity Shop.
- When considering making changes to any park, the provided statistics on nearby homes and other factors can help inform those decisions.
- All the parks and the fields should have ample seating in order to accommodate users comfortably.
- Since a ball field was being considered near a cemetery, it was noted that it might be appropriate to inform the cemetery administration.

Public Comment

Erika Bassett supported preserving additional green space near the residential area adjacent to Kenning Park.

Brad Galli opposed adding a ball diamond in Kenning near Hanley Court.

VIII. Miscellaneous Communications

Enforcement of motored vehicle rules within parks was discussed.

1. Advocacy for a Concrete Replacement of the Birmingham Skatepark Communication

Staff presented the item and answered questions.

Board members discussed the following regarding the item:

- Prefabricated sections have lower initial costs and higher maintenance costs than concrete.
- Adding a sidewalk between the Forest Hills Swim Club and the Skatepark would be welcome.

SUBJECT: Crestview Sound-Dampening Curtain Installation Update

The Department of Public Services (DPS) would like to provide an update on the installation of the sound-dampening curtain at the Crestview pickleball courts.

The curtain installation is near completion. While the majority of the system is in place, two panels were discovered to be missing and have since been delivered as of last week. Parks staff is coordinating the installation of the remaining panels, which is expected to be completed prior to the May Parks and Recreation Board meeting.

Staff and nearby residents have already reported a noticeable improvement in noise levels. This early feedback is encouraging and suggests the curtain will be an effective solution once fully installed.

Staff will continue to monitor conditions and gather feedback following full installation to evaluate overall performance.

SUBJECT: Citywide Playground Improvements Update

West Lincoln Well Park

Parking and driveway improvements are currently underway with concrete/sidewalk work scheduled as well.



Poppleton Park

Poppleton Park playground equipment has arrived at the park, earlier than expected. Parking designs are anticipated to be completed soon after which grading elevations can be determined for the ADA parking spaces adjacent to the park and the ADA-compliant pathway leading to the playground. The contractor expects to establish these design grades as soon as possible, allowing playground assembly to begin in the next couple of weeks. Assembly of the play equipment is expected to take approximately 5–6 weeks.

Staff attended the April Birmingham Rotary meeting to present the Poppleton Park playground project and formally accept the Rotary's contribution of \$50,000 toward the park project.

We are planning for a ribbon cutting ceremony once construction is complete!

Pembroke Park Playground

Upon approval by the City Commission on March 9, 2026, the playground equipment for Pembroke Park has been ordered. The Pembroke Playground installation is planned for this summer, including drainage improvements.

Crestview Park Playground

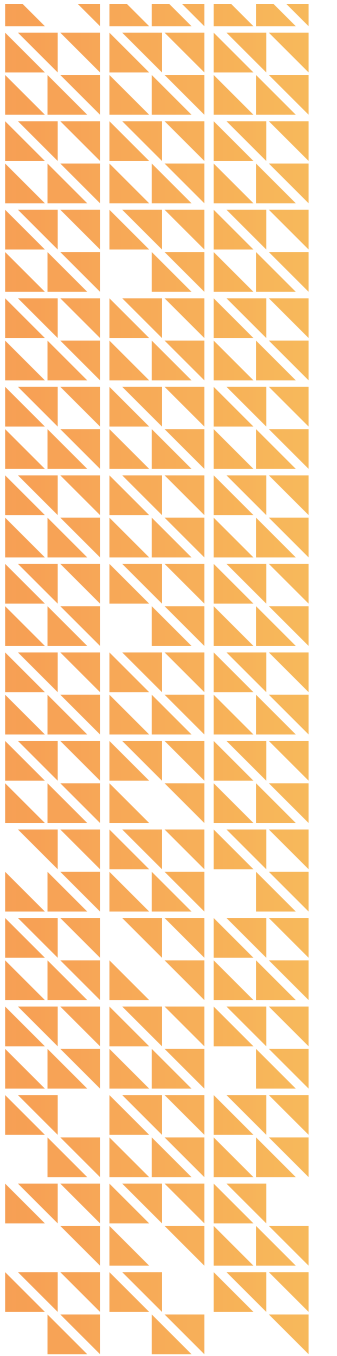
We anticipate a public workshop to occur at the June or July Parks and Recreation Board meeting to begin designs for the Crestview play area.

Community Engagement

Engagement Overview

In from February - May 2026, the City of Birmingham and OHM Advisors engaged Birmingham residents and park users to reimagine the areas within St. James and Kenning Park. This section summarizes the community engagement process that will help cultivate parks and spaces that embrace active use and nature and connect community members.

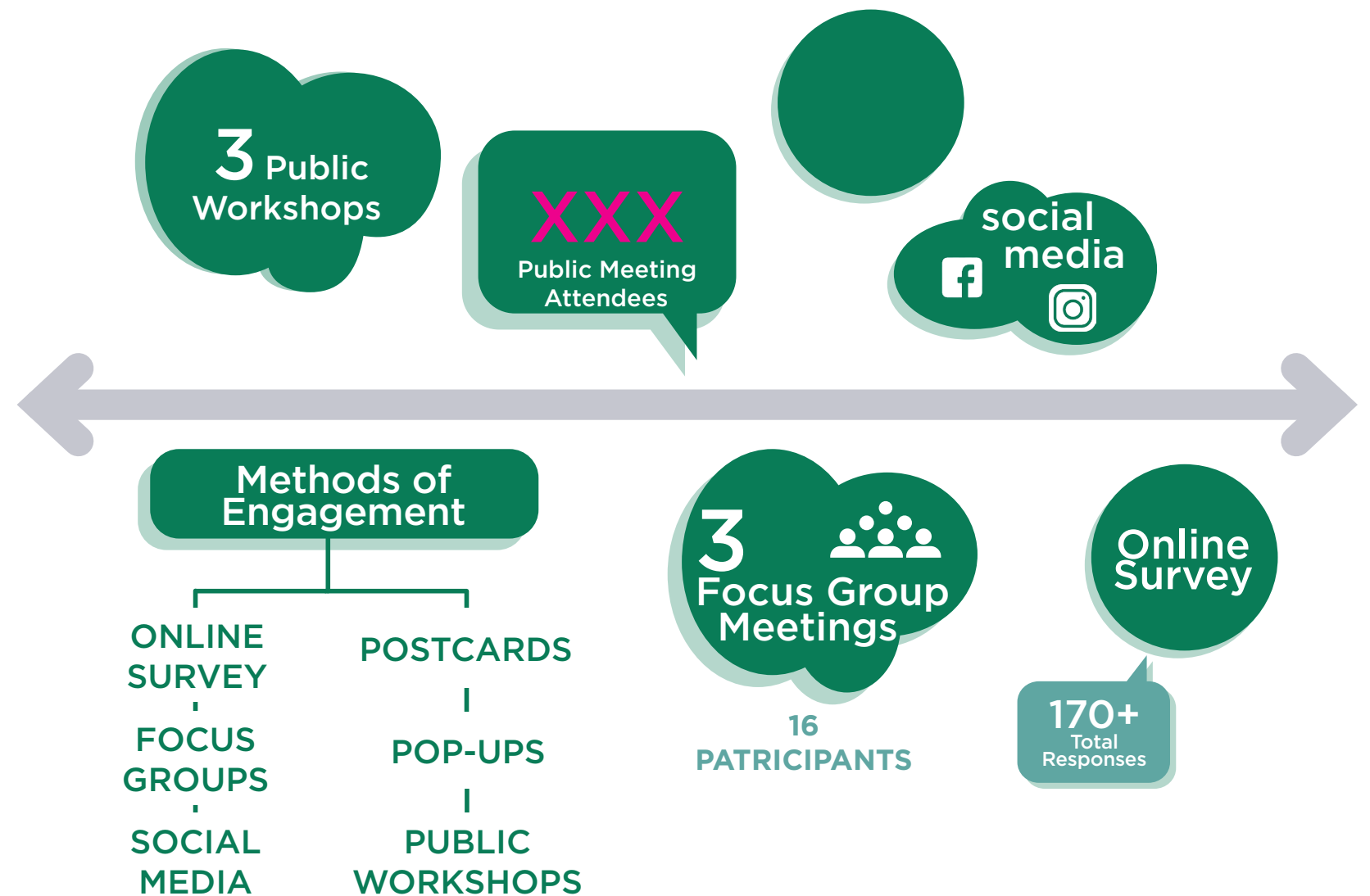
The City of Birmingham already planned basic improvements to St. James and Kenning Parks through the recent update to their Parks and Recreation Master Plan, such as playground enhancements. Implementation of the vision will go beyond these improvements to create truly unique and well-utilized places in the parks.

Engagement Goals

- 1 *Translate the 2024-2028 Parks and Recreation Master Plan concepts into refined designs*
- 2 *Gain a deeper understanding of neighborhood-specific concerns*
- 3 *Strategically filter feedback to balance the needs of immediate neighbors, the broader Birmingham community, and regional park visitors*

Engagement Approach

The first guiding principle for the St. James and Kenning Park Improvement Project is to develop recommendations which reflect community desires. The project included a robust outreach and engagement effort with a multi-faceted approach to reach Birmingham residents, as well as multiple opportunities to provide feedback.



Focus Groups

The project team invited representatives of organizations, nonprofits, homeowners associations, residential complexes, and adjacent property owners with strong connections to St. James and Kenning Park to participate in a series of focus groups. Two rounds of three focus groups were held at crucial points of the planning and design process in order for participants to provide feedback on the concept development and raise concerns.



Community Stakeholders

Athletics and Fields

- There is a major lack of adequate baseball/softball facilities in the area. High priorities include improving drainage to extend the playing season (currently unusable in March/April) and installing turf to reduce maintenance.

Senior Needs (NEXT Birmingham)

- With NEXT moving adjacent to St. James, there is a critical need for safe, paved walking paths (not wood chips), outdoor fitness equipment, and shaded picnic areas for social gatherings.

Skate Park

- The current skate park is outdated and at the end of its life. Stakeholders suggested a modern concrete design that is “sculptural” and integrated into the park, including a “learning loop” for younger children on bikes or scooters.

Connectivity

- Many users walk or bike to these parks. Improving “buffer” zones between playgrounds and roads, as well as general pedestrian infrastructure, was highly recommended.



Softball and Little League

Facility Gaps

- Current facilities are not on par with surrounding areas; Birmingham’s high standard of living is not reflected in the ball diamonds at either park.

St. James Park

- Strong desire for permanent restrooms to host district competitions.
- Other requested upgrades include synthetic turf, defined outfields, and formal covered dugouts.

Kenning Park

- There is a major concern regarding the potential loss of the 4th field.
- While a dedicated softball field is supported, the league highlighted a lack of restroom and concession access in July when the Ice Arena is shut down.

Operations

- The league is interested in vending options for snacks and drinks but is not interested in organizing food trucks themselves.
- Support for field lights and improved storage sheds.



Focus Groups



Maintenance Team

Athletics and Fields

- Daily grooming is time-intensive. After the Little League season ends, the fields are still groomed at least 2 times per week.

Water Access and Drainage

- Severe drainage issues at both parks prevent essential maintenance, such as tree trimming, because the ground is too soft for heavy equipment. Pathways must be able to support the maintenance vehicles.
- Staff suggested dedicated pads with drains for ice shavings at the arena to prevent seasonal flooding.
- The maintenance crew needs water access to power wash play equipment.

Maintenance Efficiency

- Staff recommended installing cement pads under all bleachers and curbing around playgrounds to keep wood chips contained and make mowing/cleanup easier.
- Trash collection is time-intensive.

Safety and Lighting

- Kenning Park is described as “pitch black” in winter due to dense tree cover, posing safety concerns. Improved lighting is needed, specifically around the playground areas.

Green Stormwater Infrastructure

- While bioswales are used for stormwater, staff warned that existing rain gardens (like at Adams Park) are too high-maintenance due to excessive weeding requirements.
- Prefer rip-rap or stone substrate to prevent mulch from clogging drains.

Public Workshop #1

The first public workshop was held on April 14, 2026 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the Department of Public Services (DPS) building in Birmingham. Around 50 people attended the workshop. The workshop’s goals were to inform attendees about the project, gather feedback on design considerations, and share 2-3 initial concepts for each park. This touchpoint was complemented by the online survey, which was implemented to capture input from people who were unable to attend the community meeting, and understand how they use the parks and what they see as important in their future.

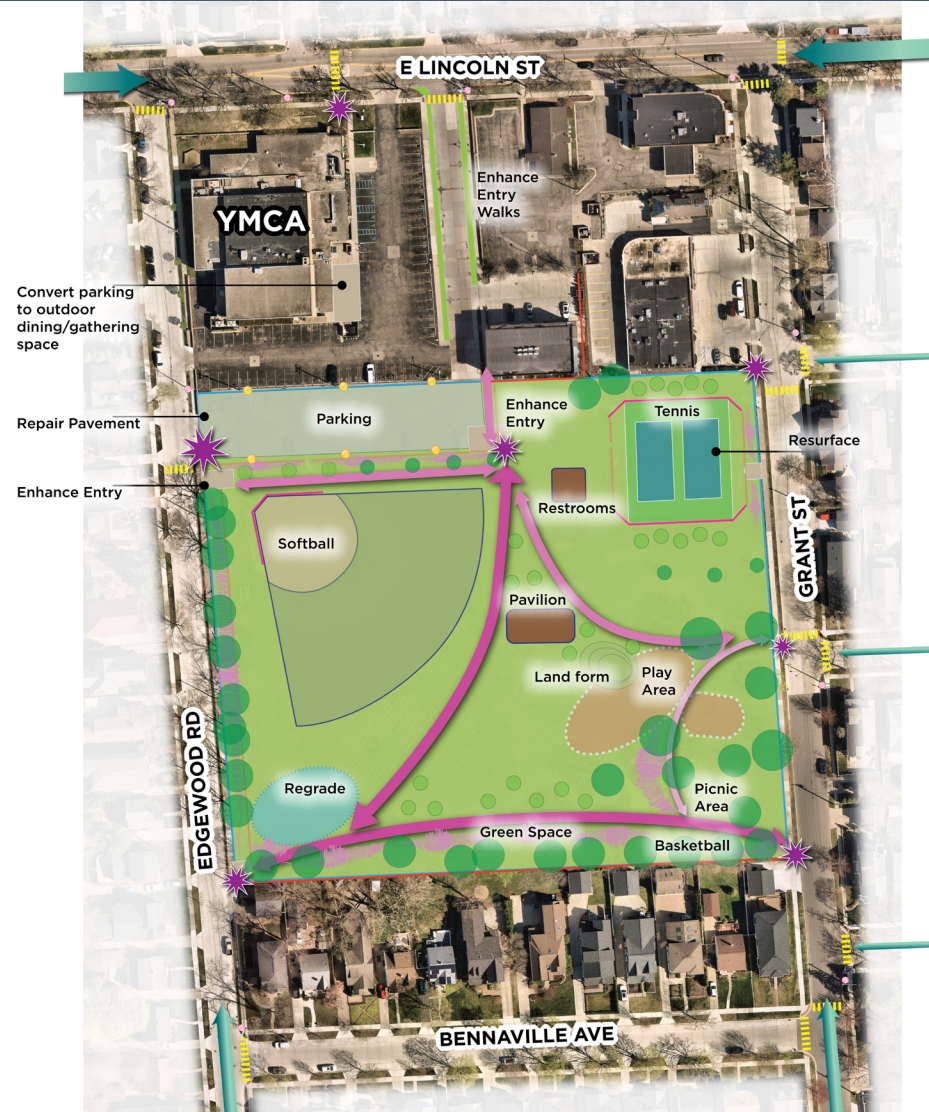

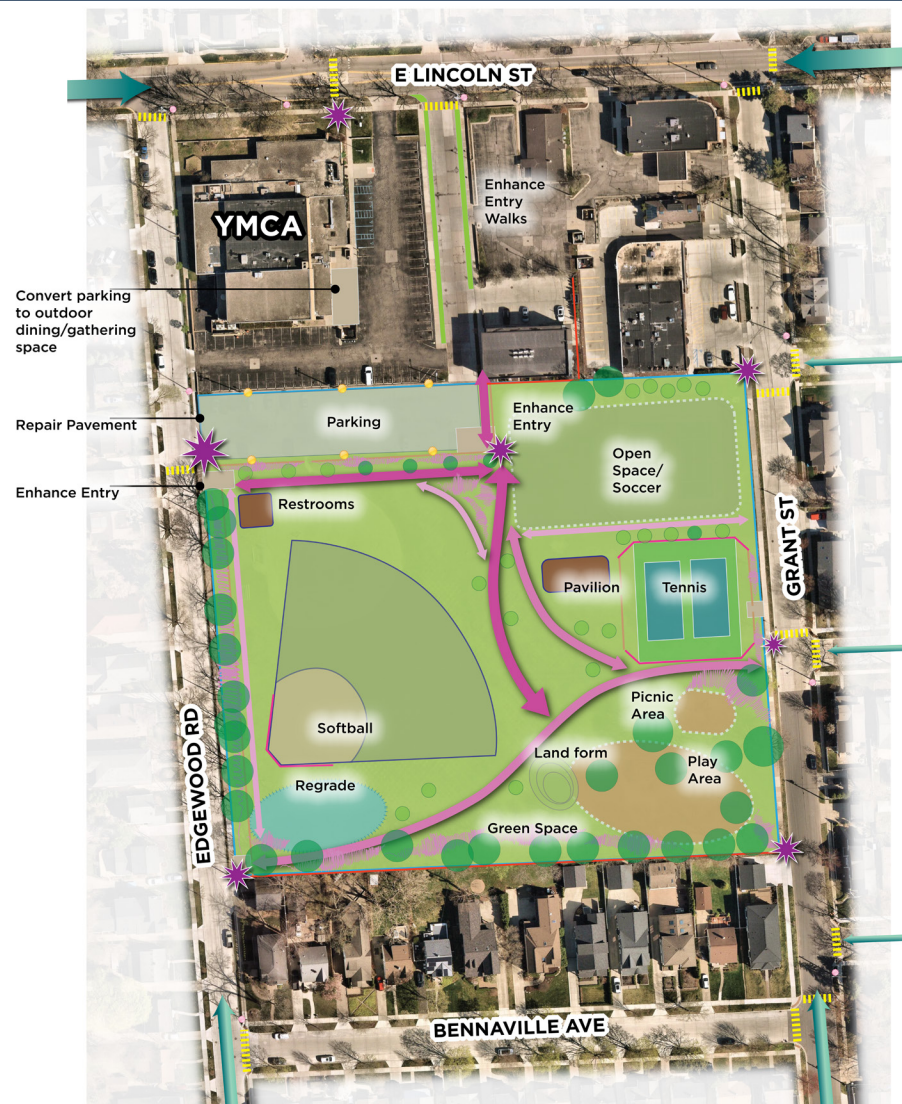

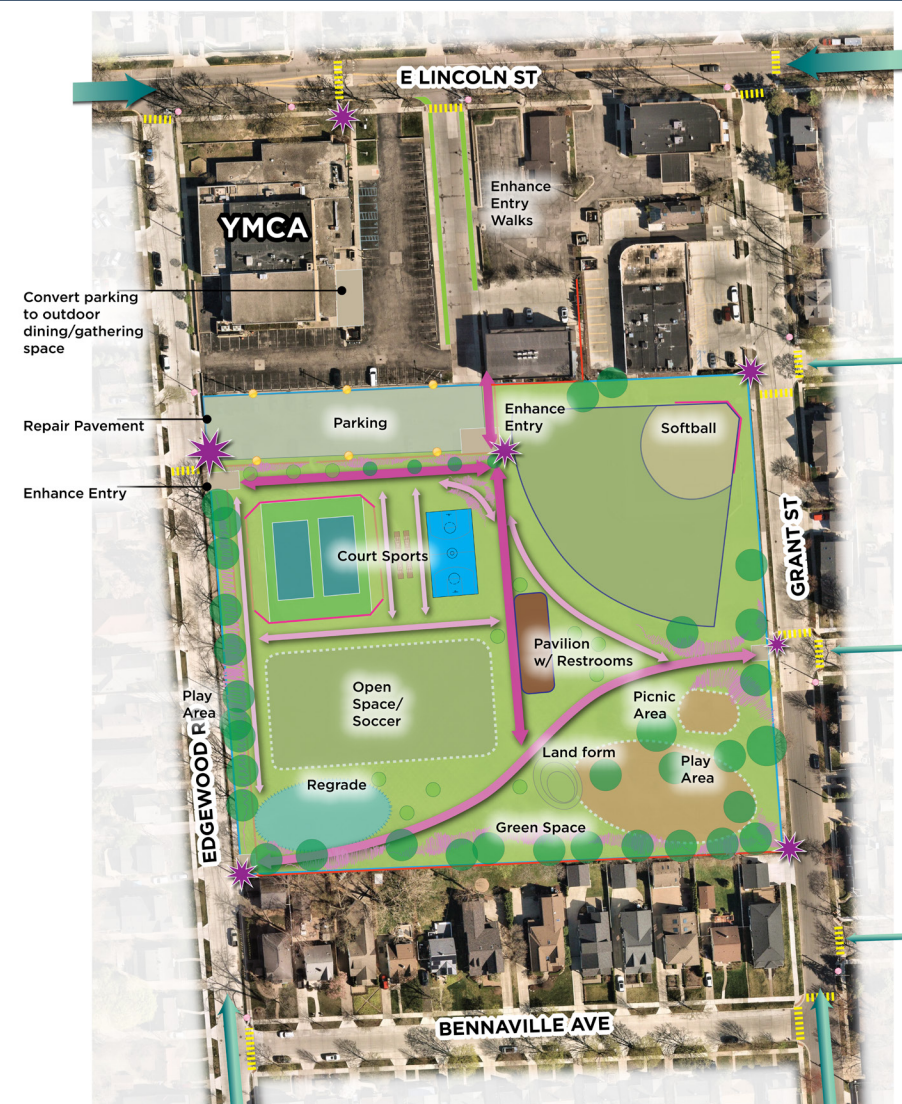

Key Observations

- This graphic further refines the arrangement for the site elements proposed in the earlier Master Plan and incorporates feedback gathered from public engagement efforts.
- The third little league diamond has been rotated in its current location to provide better accessory gathering space and allow for a connecting path between the fields to the southwest.
- Upgrades to the fields come in the form of paved spectator seating areas.
- Regrading the outfield of the Softball diamond allows for a youth soccer field.
- The proposed play and adjacent picnic pavilion area are nestled in the southwest corner, situated among the existing tree canopy and adjacent to an arc of the park's exercise path.
- The main park entrance in the northwest has been reorganized to streamline the walking routes while maximizing green space and allow for bio-retention for mitigation of tennis dome runoff.
- Additional pedestrian paths have been added to better connect the site use areas.
- A centrally located restroom and concessions stand building addition is proposed for the southwest corner of the Ice Arena.
- An angled open air pavilion connects to this addition and provides shelter for the new plaza space provided at this location.
- The central parking lot has been modified to create a formal space for ice melt drop off and relocating the dumpster enclosure.
- A small shade shelter is proposed between the little league diamonds.
- Another shelter is proposed connected to the outdoor tennis courts covering a new plaza for seating.

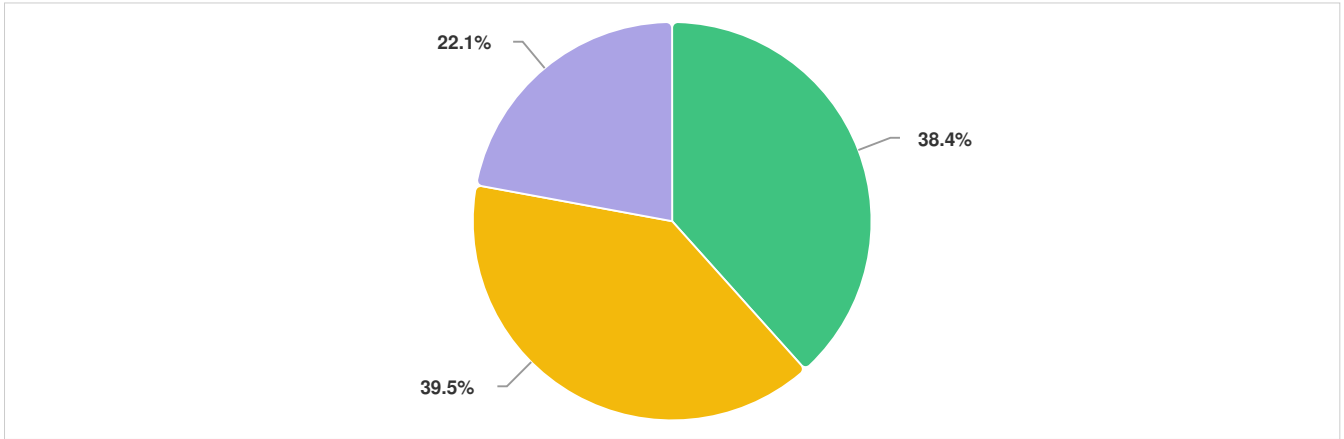

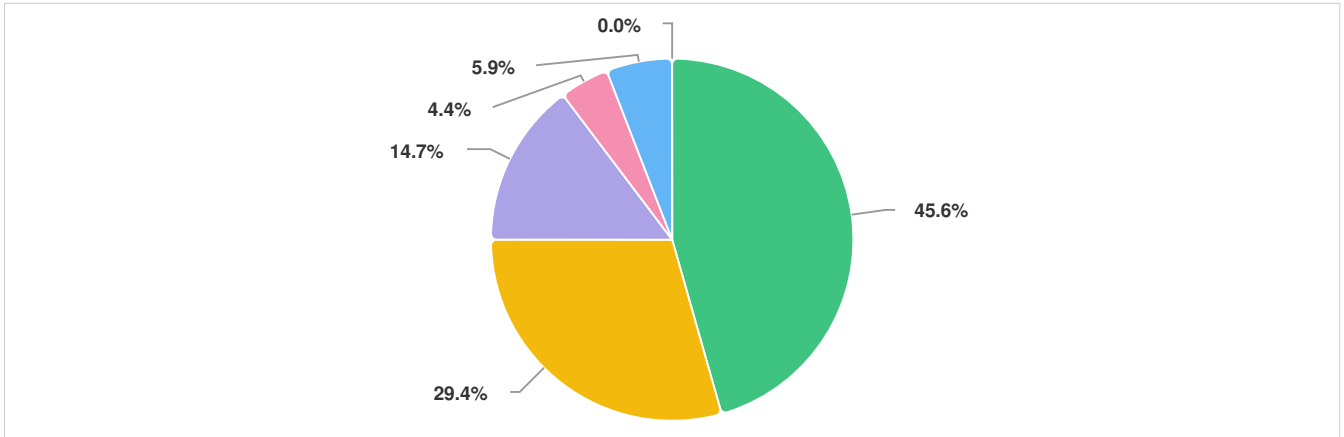

Q4. How often do you visit Kenning Park?

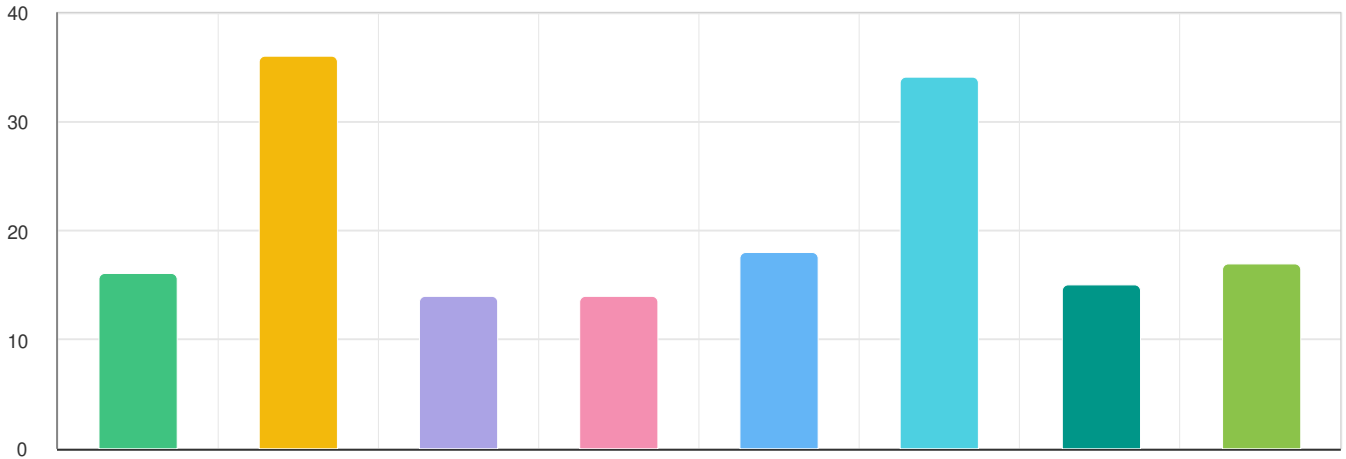

Choose up to 3.**

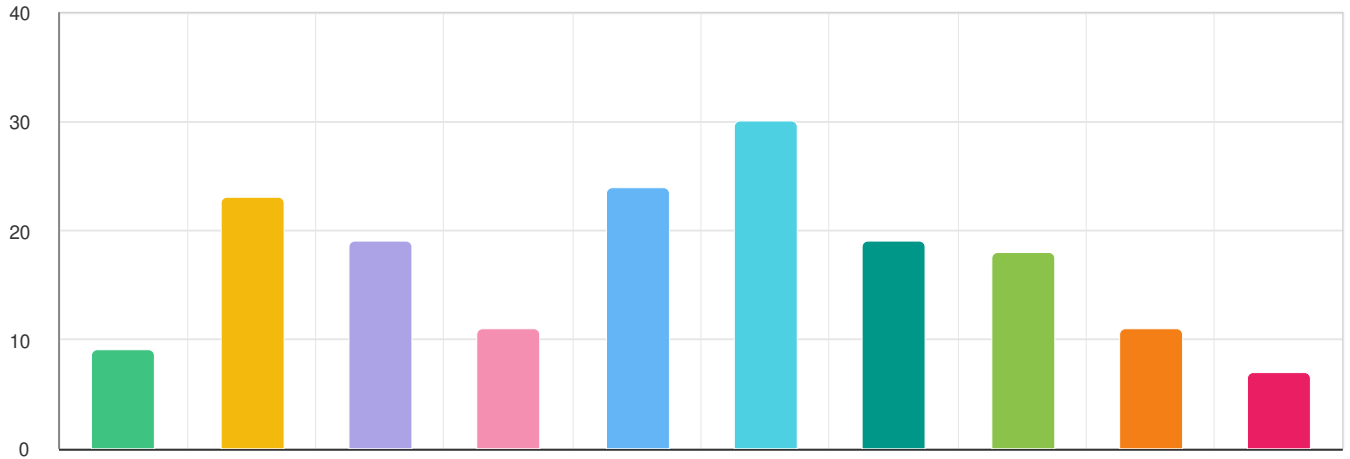

Q6. The playground equipment at Kenning Park is almost 30 years old. What are the most important features you would like to see in a new play area?

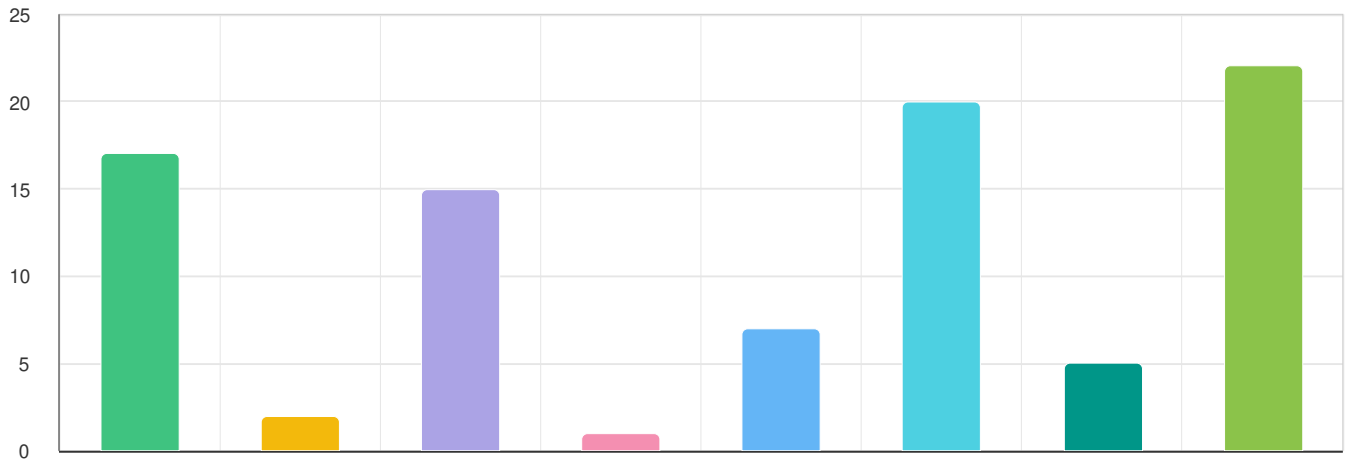

Q7. Is there anything that keeps you or others in your household from visiting Kenning Park?

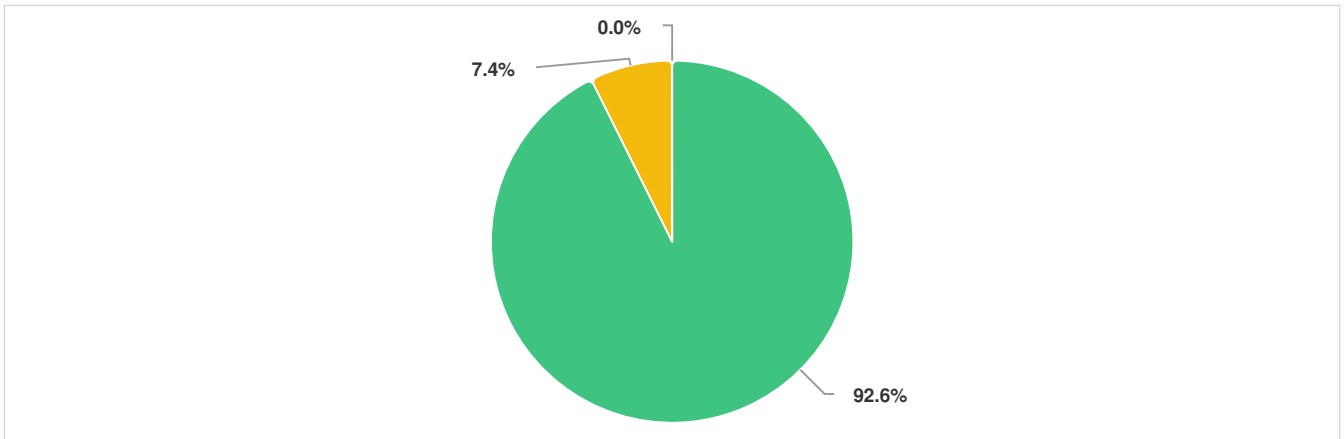

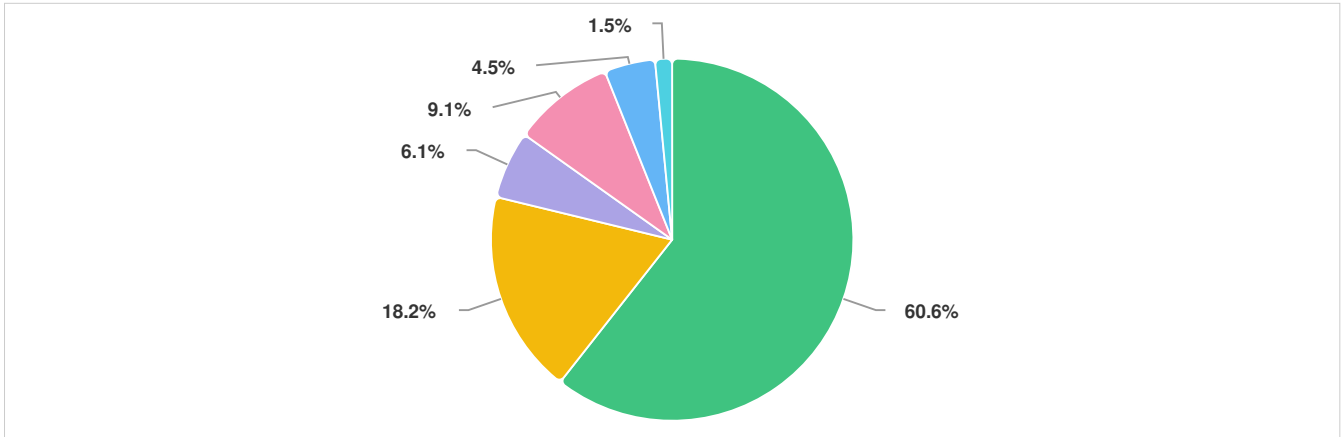

Q12. How often do you visit St. James Park?

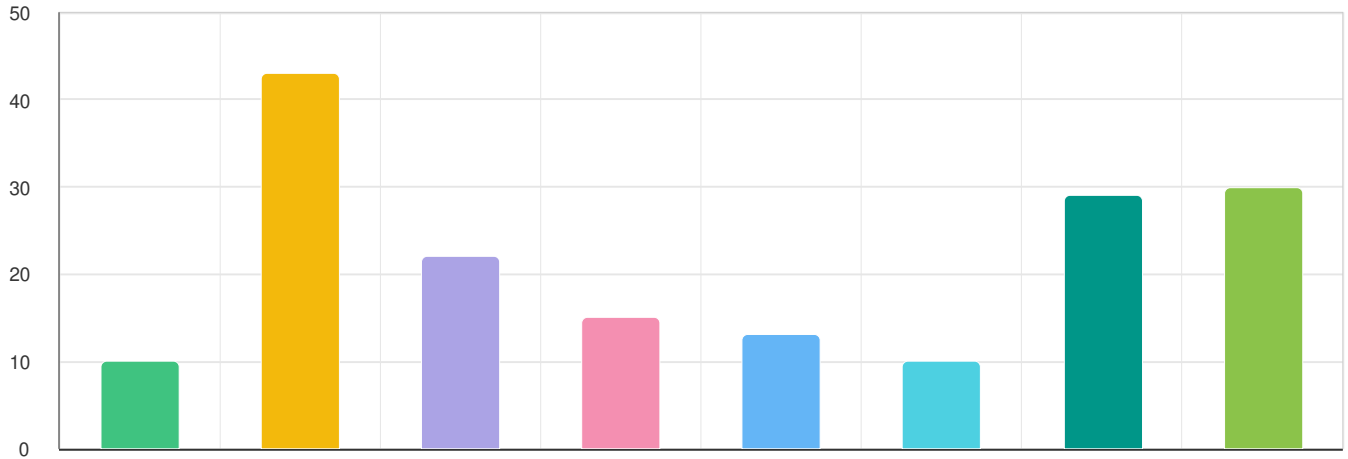

Q13. St. James Park is envisioned to become a multi-generational destination. Which features would most encourage you to visit? Choose up to 3.

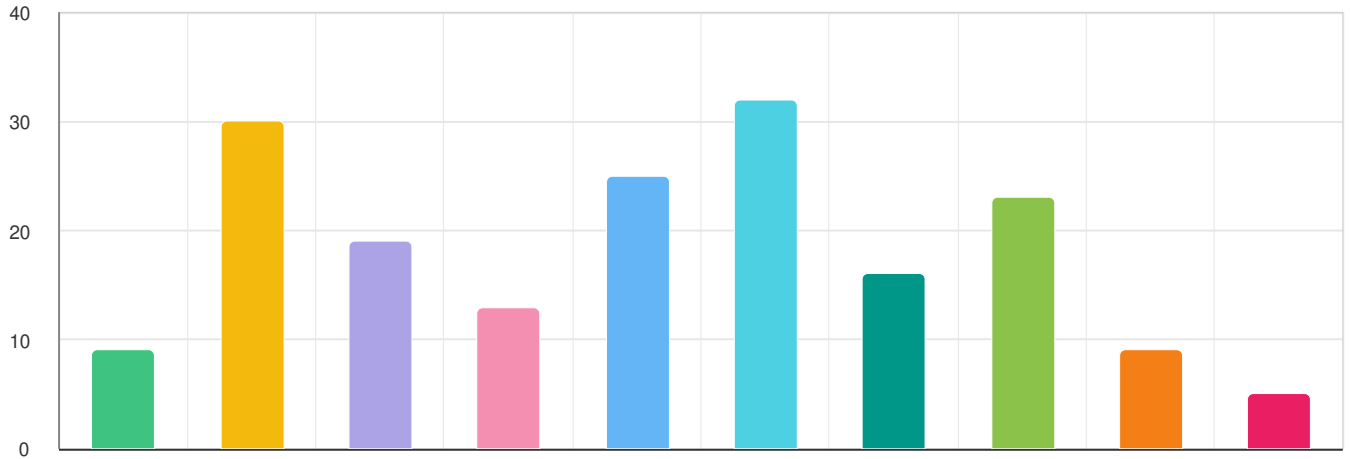

Q14. The playground equipment at St. James Park is over 20 years old. What are the most important features you would like to see in a new playground?

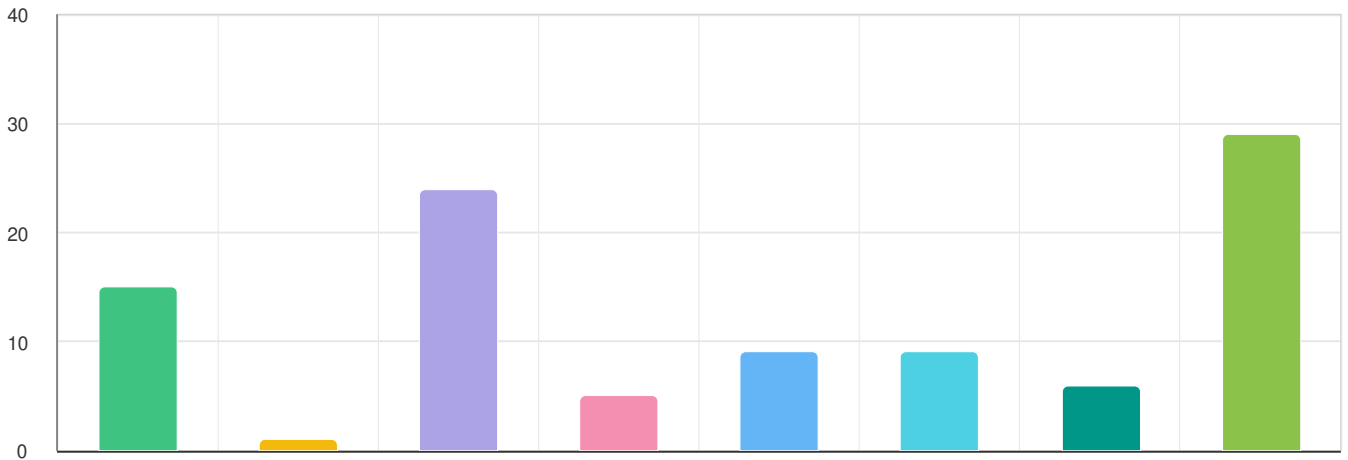

Q15. Is there anything that keeps you or others in your household from visiting St. James Park?

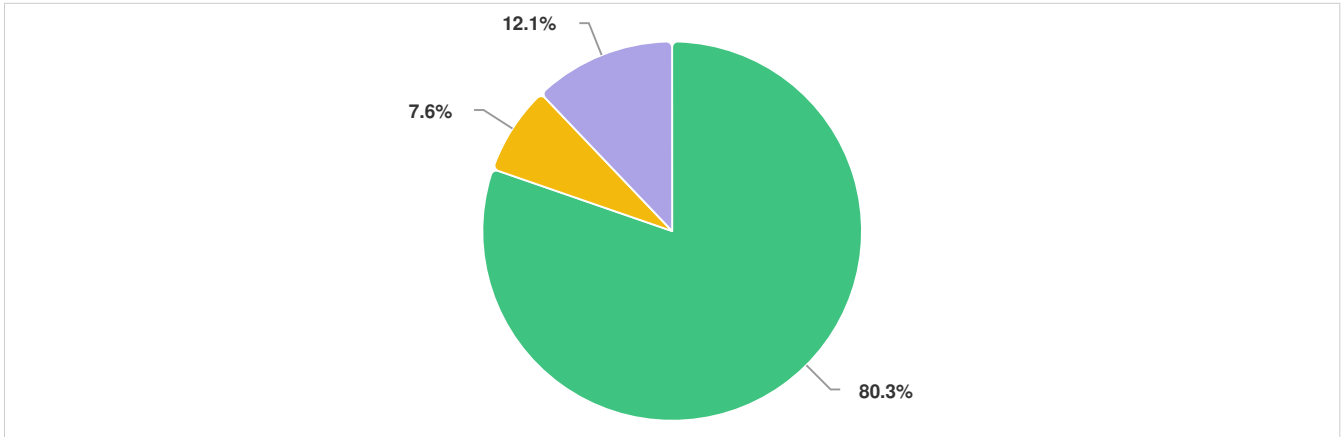

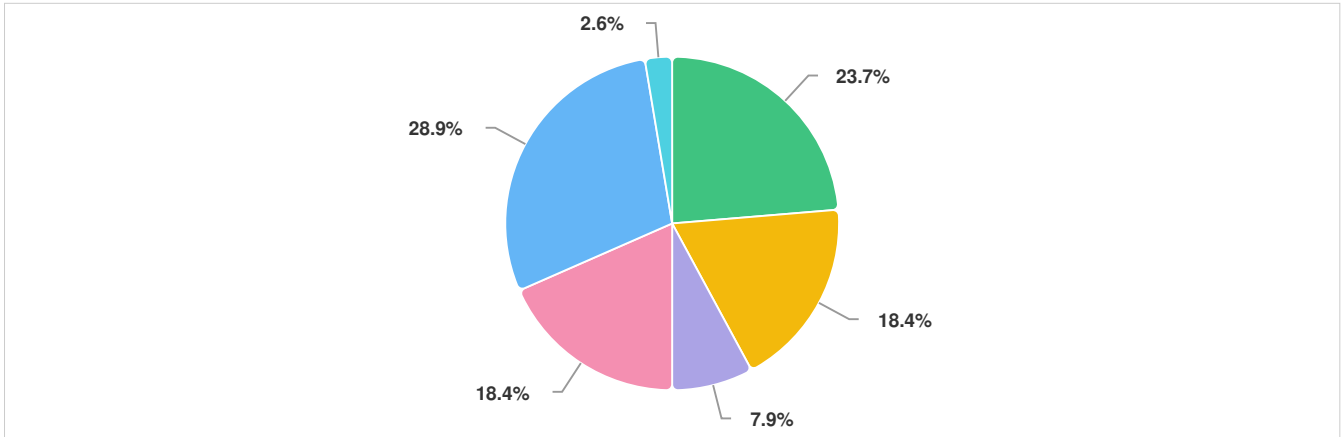

Q20. How often do you visit Kenning Park?

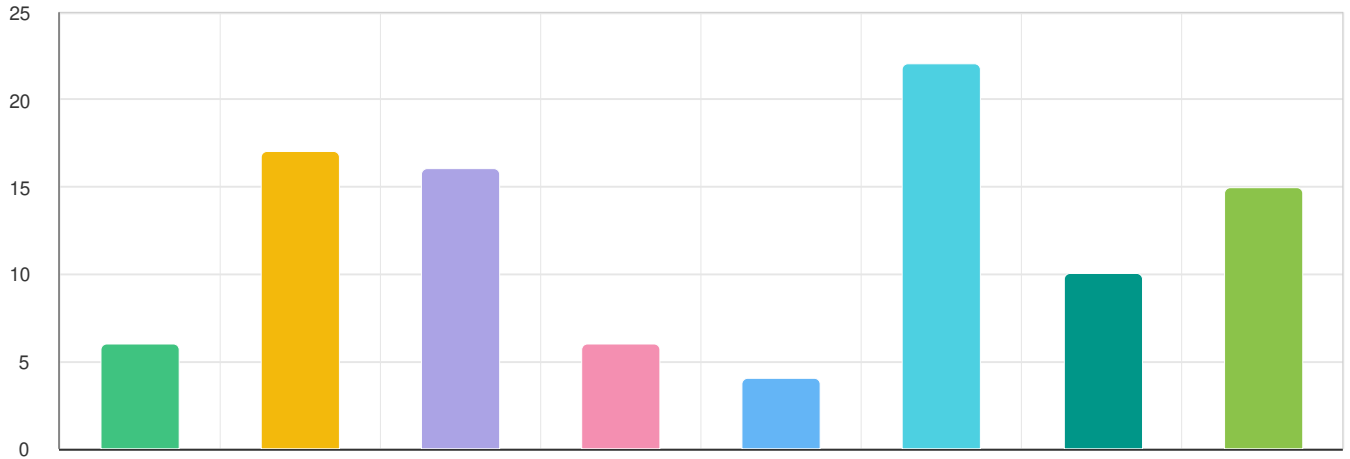

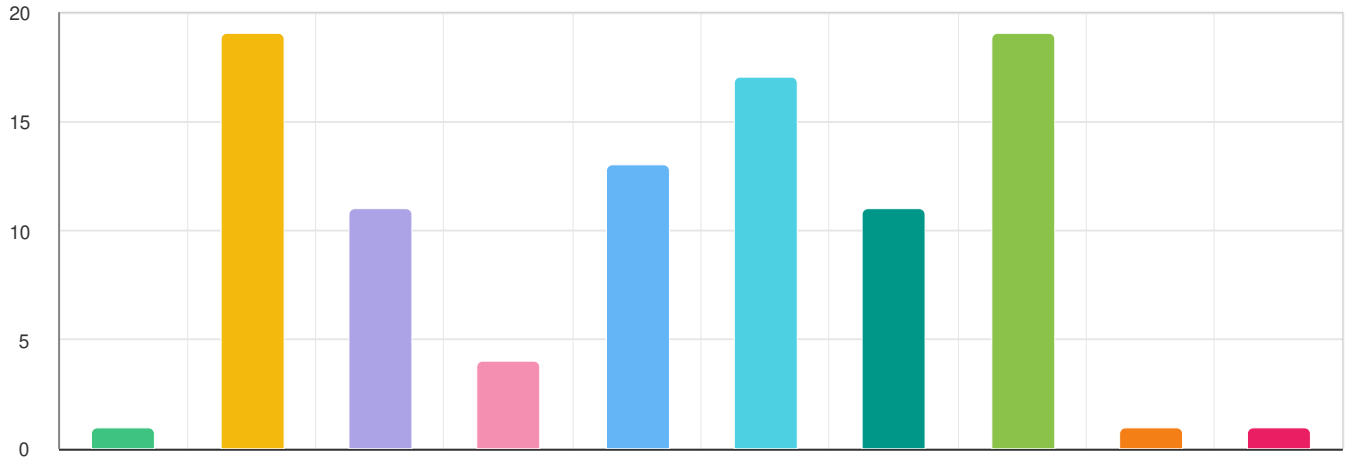

Q22. The playground equipment at Kenning Park is almost 30 years old. What are the most important features you would like to see in a new play area?

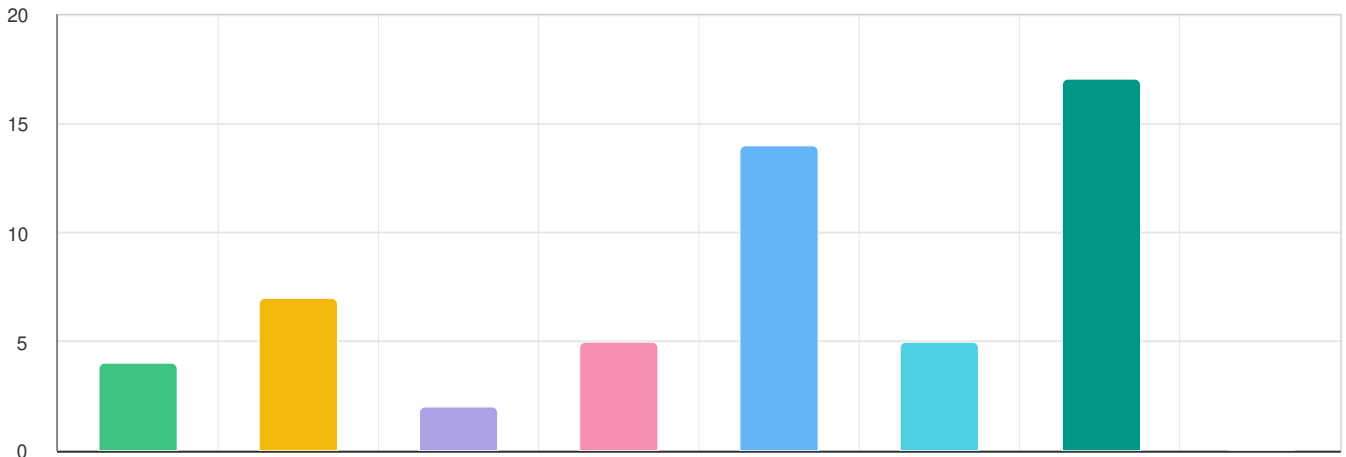

Q23. Is there anything that keeps you or others in your household from visiting Kenning Park?

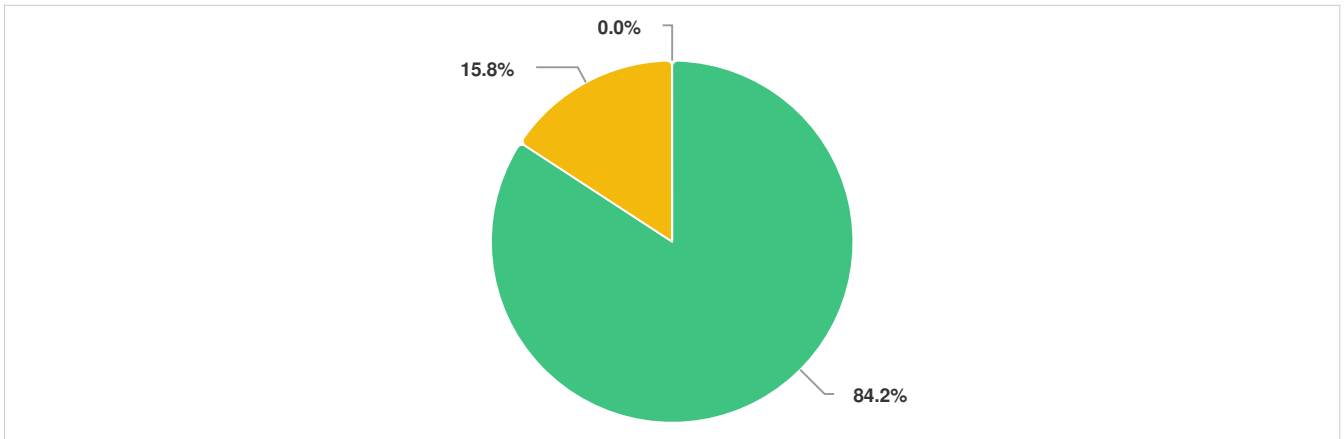

The Kenning baseball fields are very poorly maintained, specific to the field conditions (e.g., no early spring rolling of the field, infrequent mowing in the spring where kids need to dig baseballs out of tall grass, zero weed control where groundballs will take 90 degree turns, and in the summer the fields (especially fields 1 & 4 become a dust bowl, with 6 inches of dust that make them unplayable). I live in Birmingham, coach multiple Birmingham Little League teams, have three sons who play and also attend BPS. When we travel to play in peer communities (e.g., Rochester, Grosse Pointe) it is a stark difference in the conditions and quality of their fields versus the Kenning Fields, which are supposed to be our communities premier fields that underwent recent and significant investment.

Also, it is critical that the other two fields at Kenning (Fields 1 & 4) undergo renovation, with strong recommendation for the fields (at least the infields) be turf fields, which will help with the maintenance issues and allow our kids to play even after rain events that would otherwise shut down the fields.

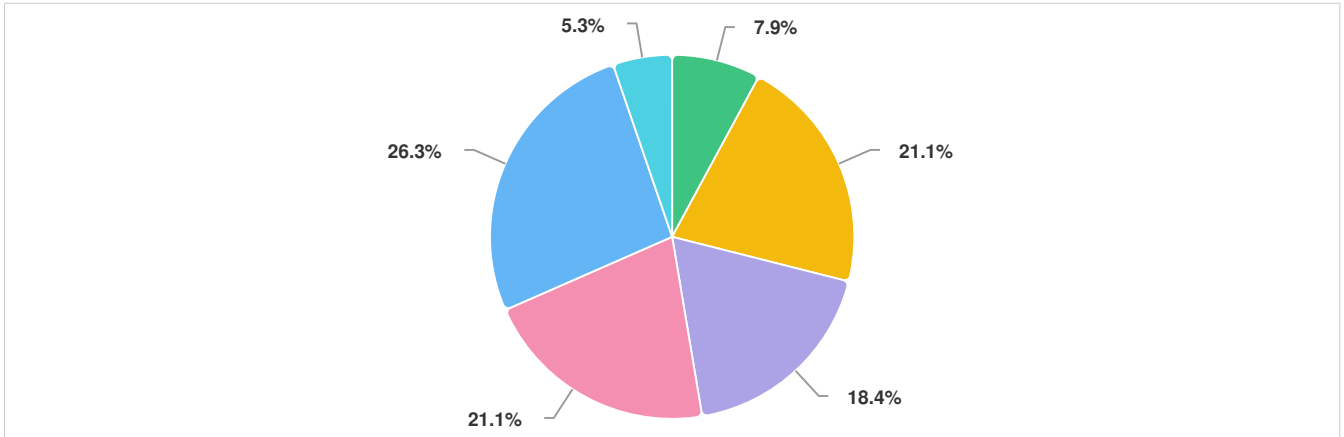

Q28. How often do you visit St. James Park?

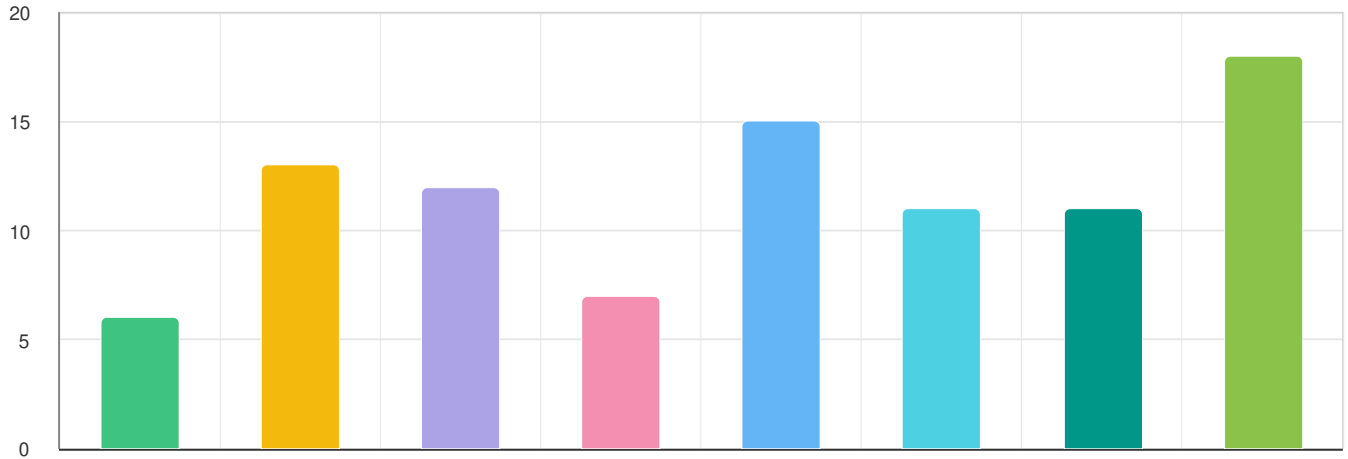

Q29. St. James Park is envisioned to become a multi-generational destination. Which features would most encourage you to visit? Choose up to 3.

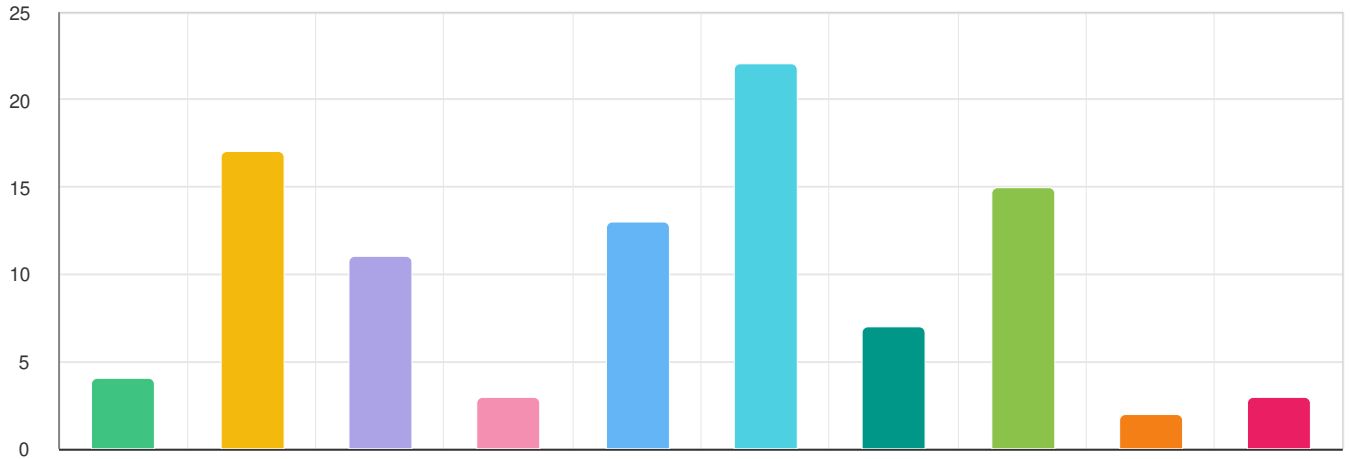

Q30. The playground equipment at St. James Park is over 20 years old. What are the most important features you would like to see in a new playground?

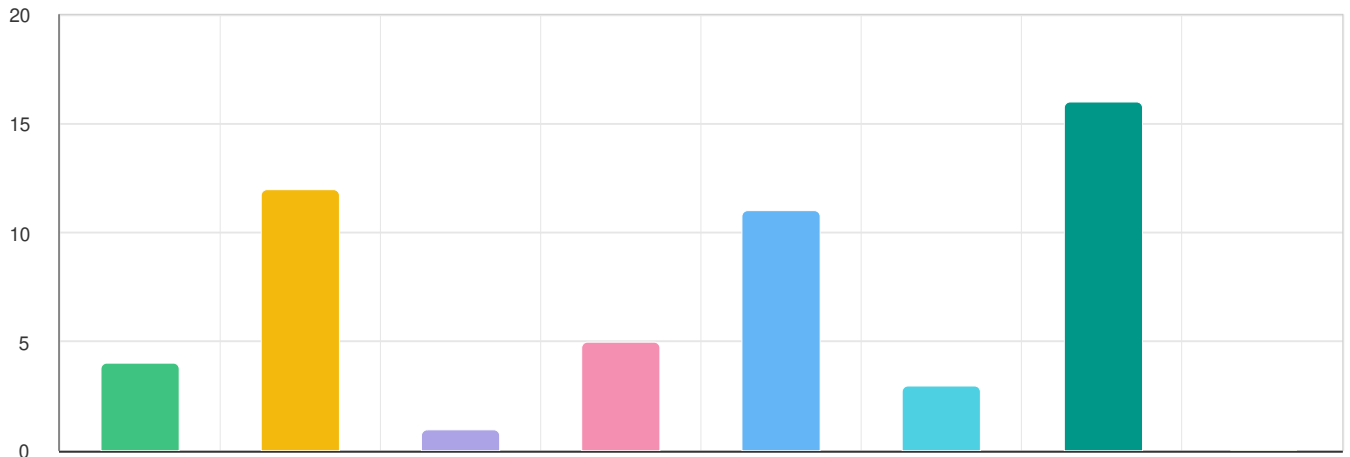

Q31. Is there anything that keeps you or others in your household from visiting St. James Park?

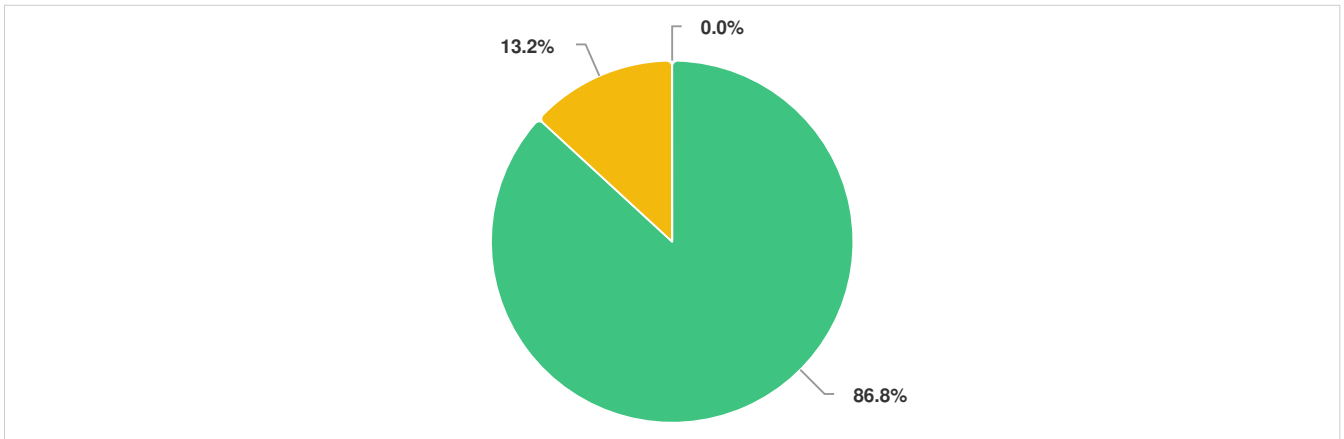

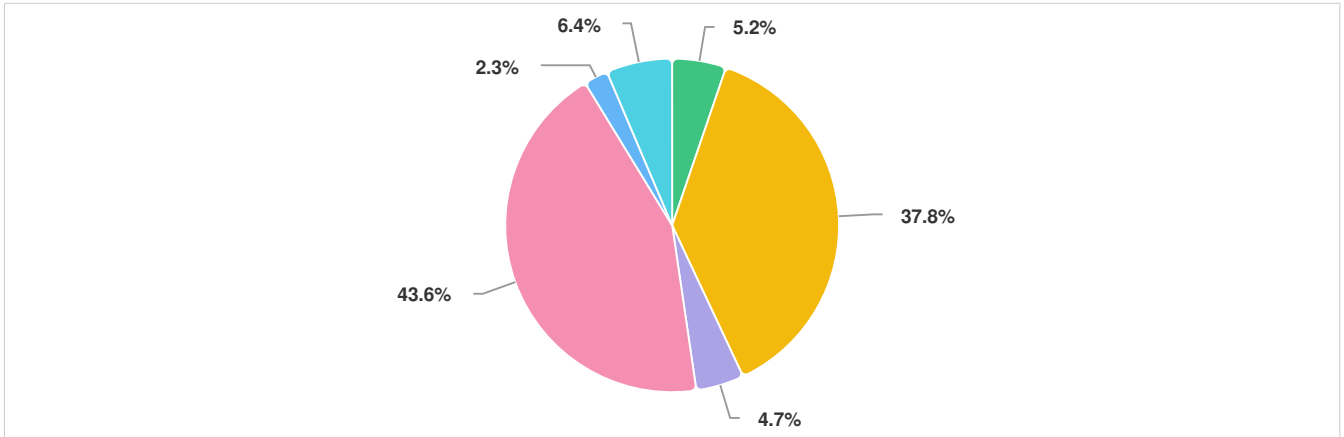

Q34. Where on the map do you live?

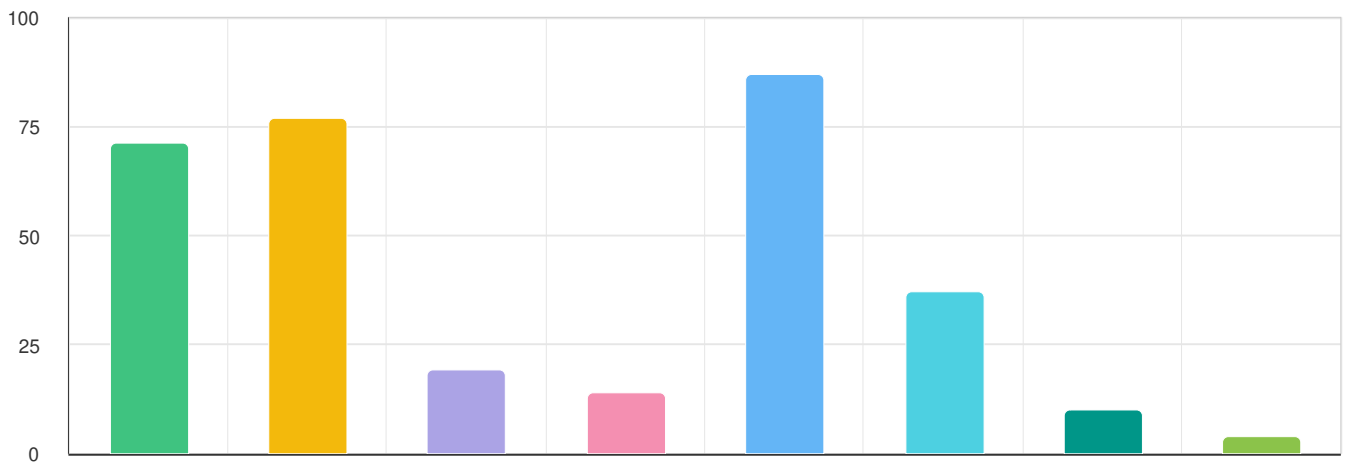

Q35. Who are the primary users of parks in your household? Select all that apply.

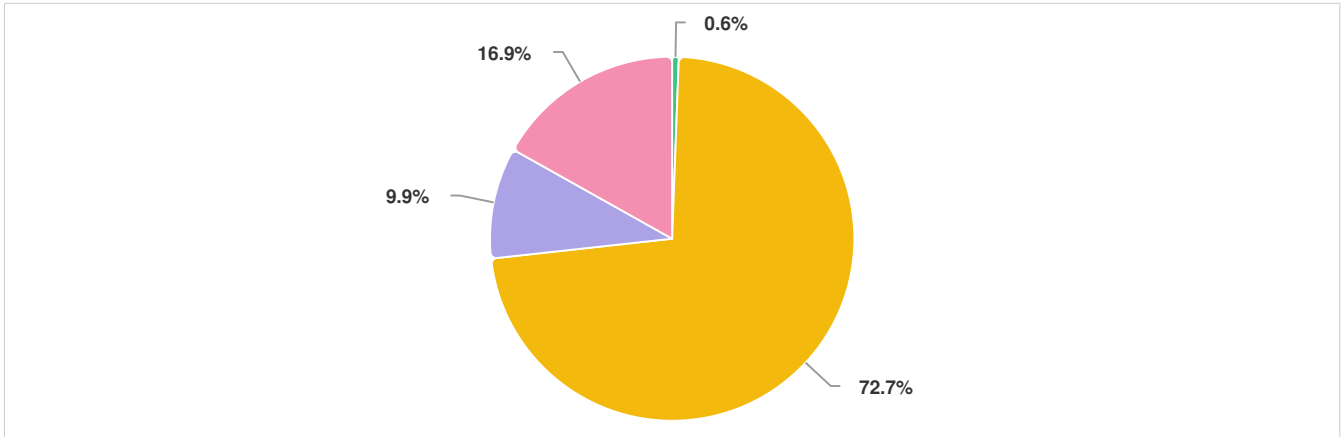
